

PAPER PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPAMEC 2011 (L^AT_EX TEMPLATE)

ABSTRACT

SPAMEC 2011 welcomes the submission of papers in areas of Signal Processing and Applied Mathematics for Electronics and Communications. The abstract should contain about 100 to 150 words.

Keywords: *IEEE keywords, IEEE taxonomy.*

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The goal of these instructions is to specify the format and style of SPAMEC 2011. Papers submitted to SPAMEC 2011 must describe original, unpublished work. Papers must conform to the format and style specified in Section 2. The maximum paper length including references is four pages. The deadline for the submission of full papers is May 10, 2011.

Based on comments from the reviewers, it will be possible to make minor changes to your paper before it is submitted in its final, camera-ready form on July 10, 2011. Accepted papers will be published in SPAMEC 2011 Proceedings and in EURASIP Open Library.

At least one author of each accepted paper must register for the conference no later than July 20, 2011.

2. PAPER FORMAT AND STYLE

In case of acceptance, the electronic paper version (**PDF file**) submitted by you will be directly reproduced in SPAMEC 2011 Proceedings and in EURASIP Open Library.

2.1 Format

All material must fit in a 172×240 mm (6.77×9.45 inch) area with a left and a right margin of 19 mm (0.75 inch) and a top margin of 25 mm (1 inch). On the first page, the top margin has to be 32 mm (1.26 inch).

All text must appear in two columns with a column spacing of 6 mm (0.24 inch). Do not put page numbers, headers or footers on your document.

2.2 Style

All text must be single spaced. The recommended font size is 10 point and the recommended font is Times Roman or Times New Roman (default with SPAMEC2011.sty).

2.2.1 Title

The paper title is to appear in boldface capital letters, centered across the top of the two columns on the first page. The recommended font size for the paper title is 14 point.

The names of the authors should appear below the title, centered: first name (lowercase), surname (uppercase). The recommended font size for the authors' names is 11 point.

The affiliations, addresses, and email addresses should appear below the authors' names using 10 point font size (default with SPAMEC2011.sty).

2.2.2 Abstract and Keywords

The paper abstract appears below the title on the first page as the first item on the left-hand column (unnumbered). The text of the abstract should be in italic letters. Allow 11 mm (0.43 inch) vertical space between title area and abstract.

The keywords must follow the abstract. The text of the keywords should be in italic letters.

2.2.3 Headings

Major headings should be numbered and appear in boldface capital letters, centered within the respective column;

Subheadings should be numbered, left aligned in the respective column, and in boldface letters.

Sub-subheadings should be left aligned in the respective column and in italic letters; they may be numbered.

2.2.4 Figures and Tables

All figures and tables must be referred in the paper; they should be placed within the paragraph. Figures and tables must be numbered and have captions (e.g., Figure 1);

Large figures and tables may span the two columns, and should be placed on top of the respective page if possible.

2.2.5 Equations

Equations should be centered within the respective column, e.g.,

$$A(\omega) = \frac{1}{\pi} \frac{a}{a^2 + (\omega + \omega_0)^2}. \quad (1)$$

2.2.6 References

References should be numbered in order of appearance in the paper. They are referred to by the respective reference number enclosed by square brackets (e.g., [1, 3]).

3. PAPER SUBMISSION

Papers must be submitted through the SPAMEC 2011 submission system

under the item *Papers Submission*.

4. REVIEW PROCESS AND REGISTRATION

A committee of reviewers selected by the International Scientific Committee will review the submitted papers and rate them according to quality, relevance, and correctness. The conference scientific committee will use these reviews to determine which papers will be accepted for presentation in the conference. The result of the scientific committee's decision will be communicated to the submitting authors by email.

Be sure that at least one author registers to attend the conference using the online registration system available through the conference website:

under the item *Registration*. A **registration** by (at least) one of the paper (co)authors is required for each accepted paper, in order to be published.

Camera-ready final paper : July 10, 2011

Deadline for authors' early registration: July 20, 2011
